- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and matches or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Junior members must conduct themselves in a non-disruptive manner at training and during matches, showing respect at all times to coaches, volunteers and parents, carers or guardians associated with the club.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke, consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
